A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to prestige license plates and special plates for certain persons and vehicles, so as to
- 3 expand eligibility for certain members of the military to receive special license plates; to add
- 4 a military honor to the military service award eligible for special and distinctive license
- 5 plates for veterans; to provide for a special and distinctive license plate for United States
- 6 Army Rangers; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 11 prestige license plates and special plates for certain persons and vehicles, is amended by
- 12 revising Code Section 40-2-85.1, relating to special and distinctive license plates for certain
- veterans, by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (a) as follows:
- 14 "(1) 'Military medal award' means the following medals, decorations, or other recognition
- of honor for military service awarded by a branch of the United States military:
- 16 (A) Medal of Honor;
- 17 (B) Bronze Star Medal;
- 18 (C) Silver Star Medal;
- 19 (D) Distinguished Service Cross;
- 20 (E) Navy Cross;
- 21 (F) Air Force Cross;
- (G) Defense Distinguished Service Medal;
- 23 (H) Homeland Security Distinguished Service Medal;
- 24 (I) Distinguished Service Medal;
- 25 (J) Navy Distinguished Service Medal;
- 26 (K) Air Force Distinguished Service Medal;
- 27 (L) Coast Guard Distinguished Service Medal;

- 28 (M) Defense Superior Service Medal;
- 29 (N) Legion of Merit;
- 30 (O) Distinguished Flying Cross;
- 31 (P) Purple Heart;
- 32 (Q) Air Medal; and
- 33 (R) Soldier's Medal; and
- 34 (S) Meritorious Service Medal."

35 SECTION 2.

36 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 37 "<u>40-2-85.4.</u>
- 38 (a) Motor vehicle and trailer owners who are designated to United States Army Ranger
- 39 <u>units, past or present, or are graduates of the United States Army Ranger School shall be</u>
- 40 eligible to receive special and distinctive vehicle license plates for private passenger cars,
- 41 <u>trucks, motorcycles, or recreational vehicles used for personal transportation. Such license</u>
- 42 plates shall be issued in compliance with the state motor vehicle laws relating to
- 43 <u>registration and licensing of motor vehicles as prescribed in Article 2 of this chapter.</u>
- 44 (b) A person who qualifies for the special and distinctive license plate pursuant to
- 45 <u>subsection (a) of this Code section shall make application therefor with the commissioner</u>
- and include the requisite fee. The commissioner shall design a distinctive license plate as
- 47 provided in subsection (c) of this Code section and issue the distinctive license plates to
- 48 <u>qualifying applicants</u>. There shall be no minimum required number of applicants for such
- 49 <u>distinctive license plate. The commissioner shall promulgate such rules and regulations</u>
- as may be necessary to enforce compliance with all state license laws relating to the use
- 51 <u>and operation of private passenger cars and trucks before issuing these license plates in lieu</u>
- of the regular Georgia license plates. The additional manufacturing fee for such special
- 53 and distinctive license plates shall be \$25.00. The commissioner is specifically authorized
- 54 <u>to promulgate all rules and regulations necessary to ensure compliance in instances where</u>
- such vehicles have been transferred or sold.
- 56 (c) The special and distinctive vehicle license plates shall be as prescribed in Article 2 of
- 57 <u>this chapter for private passenger cars or trucks used for personal transportation, except that</u>
- 58 the commissioner shall include a special design to identify the owner as a United States
- 59 <u>Army Ranger.</u>
- 60 (d) The license plate issued pursuant to this Code section shall be transferred between
- 61 <u>vehicles as provided in Code Section 40-2-80."</u>
