The Senate Committee on Judiciary Non-Civil offers the following substitute to SB 35:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-5-70 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 cruelty to children, so as to provide that leaving certain children in vehicles under certain 3 circumstances constitutes cruelty to children in the third degree; to provide for related 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 16-5-70 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to cruelty to
8	children, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:
9	"(d) Any person commits the offense of cruelty to children in the third degree when:
10	(1) Such person, who is the primary aggressor, intentionally allows a child under the age
11	of 18 to witness the commission of a forcible felony, battery, or family violence battery;
12	or
13	(2) Such person, who is the primary aggressor, having knowledge that a child under the
14	age of 18 is present and sees or hears the act, commits a forcible felony, battery, or family
15	violence battery <u>; or</u>
16	(3) Such person leaves a child six years of age or younger unattended, or supervised by
17	someone who is younger than 13 years of age, in a motor vehicle under circumstances
18	that pose a substantial risk of harm to such child's health or safety."
19	SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
