The Senate Committee on Regulated Industries and Utilities offered the following substitute to SB 352:

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

69 (c)(d) Nothing contained in this Code section shall be construed to invalidate, override, or

- amend any licensing compact entered into by the State of Georgia or to permit the issuance
- 71 of a license without verification under Code Section 50-36-1."
