## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 8 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Georgia Commission on the Holocaust, so as to reassign the commission for
- 3 administrative purposes; to change the membership of the commission; to provide for the
- 4 design and placement of a memorial to the Holocaust; to provide for funding; to provide for
- 5 related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 8 of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 10 Georgia Commission on the Holocaust, is amended in Code Section 50-12-131, relating to
- membership, terms, qualifications, officers, quorum, and powers and duties, by revising
- subsections (a) and (g), respectfully, as follows:
- 13 "(a) There is created the Georgia Commission on the Holocaust in the executive branch
- of state government. The commission shall be assigned to the Office of the Secretary of
- 15 State Department of Community Affairs for administrative purposes only."
- 16 "(g) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint a member of one member
- of the majority party and one member of the minority party from the House of
- 18 Representatives and the President of the Senate shall appoint a member of one member of
- 19 <u>the majority party and one member of the minority party from</u> the Senate to serve as
- 20 <u>advisers legislative oversight</u> to the commission."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 23 "<u>50-12-134.</u>
- 24 (a) The Georgia Commission on the Holocaust shall design, procure, and place in a
- 25 <u>prominent location a Georgia Holocaust Memorial to recognize and commemorate the</u>

26 <u>millions of people, including six million Jews, murdered by the Nazis and their</u>

- 27 <u>collaborators before and during World War II.</u> Such project shall be subject to the
- 28 availability of private funds for such purpose.
- 29 (b) The monument provided for in subsection (a) of this Code section shall be designed
- and placed by the commission."
- 31 SECTION 3.
- 32 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 33 without such approval.
- 34 SECTION 4.
- 35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
