A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4,
- 2 1991 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, so as to change provisions relating to the filling
- 3 of vacancies in the offices of members of the governing authority; to provide for an
- 4 exception; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4, 1991
- 8 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 19, 2000
- 9 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3766), is amended by revising subsection (b) of Section 2.12 as follows:
- 10 "(b) Unless otherwise provided for by O.C.G.A. Section 36-30-13, a vacancy in the office
- of the mayor or any councilmember shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term,
- if any, as follows:

- 13 (1) If the vacancy occurs when six months or more remain in the term of office of the
- seat vacated, then such vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of office at a special
- election held in accordance with Georgia law; or
- 16 (2) If the vacancy occurs when fewer than six months remain in the term of office of the
- seat vacated, then the remaining members of the city governing authority shall, by
- majority vote of a quorum present and voting, select a qualified person to serve the
- remainder of the unexpired term.
- The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast in a special election under this
- subsection shall be elected."
- 22 SECTION 2.
- 23 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 2.14 as follows:
