A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales
and use taxes, so as to exempt the sale or use of certain goods designed and customarily used
for child-rearing; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1. 7 Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales and use 8 taxes, is amended by revising paragraph (49) of Code Section 48-8-3, relating to exemptions 9 from sales and use taxes, as follows: 10 "(49) The sale or use of equipment, furniture, clothing, vitamins, toys, bedding, and other 11 goods designed and customarily used for child-rearing from prenatal through age three 12 Reserved;"
