## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 4 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to financing under the "Quality Basic Education Act," so as to provide
- 3 for temporary exemption from certain financial reporting requirements for local school
- 4 systems participating in a federally authorized pilot program; to provide for related matters;
- 5 to provide for automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 8 Part 4 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to financing under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended by adding a new
- 10 Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>20-2-172.</u>
- 12 (a) For school year 2016-2017 only, a local school system which participates in a pilot
- program conducted pursuant to 20 U.S.C. Section 6414(a) under the supervision of the
- 14 Department of Education, in which such local school system consolidates its federal, state,
- and local funds as part of a school-wide program, the local school system:
- 16 (1) Shall determine which certificated professional personnel would have been funded
- by federal funds if funds were not consolidated and report such personnel to the
- department as being funded from sources other than state and local funds; and the
- department shall not pay the program adjustment amount for training and experience for
- 20 <u>such personnel, as provided in subsection (e) of Code Section 20-2-161, or contributions</u>
- 21 <u>to the health insurance fund for such personnel, as provided in Code Section 20-2-892;</u>
- 22 and
- 23 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, shall not be subject to Code Section
- 24 <u>20-2-320 or 20-2-321 and shall not be required to report expenditures of state and local</u>
- 25 <u>funds separately from federal funds and may instead report expenditures of consolidated</u>
- federal, state, and local funds.
- 27 (b) This Code section shall stand repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2017."
