The Senate Committee on Regulated Industries and Utilities offered the following substitute to SB 374:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 15 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the 2 "Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors Act of 2021," so as to change provisions 3 relating to professional land surveyors; to provide new powers to the Georgia Professional 4 Engineers and Land Surveyors Board concerning land surveyor intern certificates; to repeal 5 provisions relating to land surveyor intern certificates; to provide for experience and 6 educational requirements for licensure as a professional land surveyor; to provide for related 7 matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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SECTION 1.

10 Chapter 15 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Professional
11 Engineers and Land Surveyors Act of 2021," is amended in Code Section 43-15-6, relating
12 to general powers of board, injunctions, and continuing education, by adding a new
13 subsection to read as follows:

14 "(c) In addition to the other powers conferred upon the board under this chapter, the board 15 shall be authorized to issue land surveyor intern certificates. To be eligible for such 16 certification, an applicant shall earn a high school diploma or its equivalent, subsequently

- 17 pass a board approved examination on the fundamentals of land surveying, and complete
- 18 such additional requirements as are required by the board through rules and regulations."
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SECTION 2.

20 Said chapter is further amended by repealing Code Section 43-15-12, relating to surveyor

21 intern certificate and eligibility, and designating said Code section as reserved.

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SECTION 3.

23 Said chapter is further amended by revising Code Section 43-15-13, relating to professional

24 land surveyor license and eligibility, as follows:

25 "43-15-13.

26 To be eligible for a license as a professional land surveyor, an applicant must meet the

- 27 following minimum requirements:
- (1)(A) Obtain certification as a land surveyor intern under subparagraph (A) of
 paragraph (1) and paragraph (3) of subsection (a) of Code Section 43-15-12;

30 (B) Acquire a specific record of the equivalent of not less than four years of combined

31 office and field experience in land surveying with a minimum of three years' experience

32 in responsible charge of land surveying projects under the supervision of a professional

33 land surveyor or such other supervision deemed by the board to be the equivalent

34 thereof; and

35 (C) Subsequently pass a written examination on the principles and practices of land

36 surveying and the laws of this state relating to land surveying (professional land

37 surveyor examination);

38 (2)(A) Obtain certification as a land surveyor intern under subparagraph (B) of

- 39 paragraph (1) and paragraph (3) of subsection (a) of Code Section 43-15-12;
- 40 (B) Acquire an additional specific record of the equivalent of not less than four years
- 41 of combined office and field experience in land surveying which, together with the

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42	qualifying experience under subparagraph (B) of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of
43	Code Section 43-15-12, includes not less than four years' experience in responsible
44	charge of land surveying projects under the supervision of a professional land surveyor
45	or such other supervision deemed by the board to be the equivalent thereof; and
46	(C) Subsequently pass a written examination on the principles and practices of land
47	surveying and the laws of Georgia relating to land surveying (professional land
48	surveyor examination); or
49	(3)(A) Obtain certification as a land surveyor intern under subparagraph (C) of
50	paragraph (1) and paragraph (3) of subsection (a) of Code Section 43-15-12;
51	(B) Acquire an additional specific record of not less than four years of experience in
52	land surveying which, together with the qualifying experience under subparagraph (C)
53	of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section 43-15-12, includes not less than six
54	years' experience in responsible charge of land surveying projects under the supervision
55	of a professional land surveyor or such other supervision deemed by the board to be the
56	equivalent thereof and of a grade and character satisfactory to the board indicating that
57	the applicant is competent to practice land surveying; and
58	(C) Subsequently pass a written examination on the principles and practices of land
59	surveying and laws of this state relating to land surveying (professional land surveyor
60	examination).
61	To be eligible for licensure as a professional land surveyor, an applicant must meet the
62	minimum requirements set forth in paragraphs (1), (2), or (3) of this Code section as
63	<u>follows:</u>
64	(1) Complete the following:
65	(A) Earn a bachelor's degree in a curriculum approved by the board. Such education
66	shall include a minimum of 18 semester hours of credit, or its equivalent, in land
67	surveying subjects acceptable to the board. These credit hours may be a part of a
68	degree requirement or unrelated to such requirement:

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69	(B) Subsequent to satisfying the education requirements in subparagraph (A) of this
70	paragraph, pass the board approved fundamentals of surveying examination. The
71	applicant may, upon request to the board, obtain a certificate as a land surveyor intern
72	after the requirements in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph and this subparagraph have
73	been satisfied. Such certificate shall not be required for licensure;
74	(C) Subsequent to passing the fundamentals of surveying examination as provided in
75	subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, pass the board approved principles and practices
76	of land surveying examination;
77	(D) Subsequent to passing the principles and practices of land surveying examination
78	as provided in subparagraph(C) of this paragraph, pass the board approved examination
79	on the laws and history of land surveying in Georgia, the Georgia Professional Land
80	Surveyor examination;
81	(E) Acquire not less than three years of combined office and field experience in land
82	surveying of a nature satisfactory to the board; and
83	(F) When the requirements of subparagraphs (A) through (E) of this paragraph have
84	been satisfied, the applicant shall be eligible for licensure as a professional land
85	surveyor;
86	(2) Complete the following:
87	(A) Earn an associate's degree in a curriculum approved by the board. Such education
88	shall include a minimum of 18 semester hours of credit, or its equivalent, in land
89	surveying subjects acceptable to the board. These credit hours may be a part of a
90	degree requirement or unrelated to such requirement;
91	(B) Subsequent to satisfying the education requirements in subparagraph (A) of this
92	paragraph, pass the board approved fundamentals of surveying examination. The
93	applicant may, upon request to the board, obtain a certificate as a land surveyor intern
94	after the requirements in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph and this subparagraph have
95	been satisfied. Such certificate shall not be necessary for licensure;

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96	(C) Subsequent to passing the fundamentals of surveying examination, pass the board
97	approved principles and practices of land surveying examination;
98	(D) Subsequent to passing the principles and practices of land surveying examination,
99	pass the board approved examination on the laws and history of land surveying in
100	Georgia, the Georgia Professional Land Surveyor examination;
101	(E) Acquire not less than five years of combined office and field experience in land
102	surveying of a nature satisfactory to the board; and
103	(F) When the requirements of subparagraphs (A) through (E) of this paragraph have
104	been satisfied, the applicant shall be eligible for licensure as a professional land
105	surveyor; or
106	(3) Complete the following:
107	(A) Earn a high school diploma or its equivalent. In addition, such education shall
108	include a minimum of 18 semester hours of credit, or its equivalent, in land surveying
109	subjects acceptable to the board;
110	(B) Subsequent to satisfying the education requirements in subparagraph (A) of this
111	paragraph, pass the board approved fundamentals of surveying examination. The
112	applicant may, upon request to the board, obtain a certificate as a land surveyor intern
113	after the requirements of subparagraph (A) of this paragraph and this subparagraph
114	have been satisfied. This certificate is not necessary for licensure;
115	(C) Subsequent to passing the fundamentals of surveying examination, pass the board
116	approved principles and practices of land surveying examination;
117	(D) Subsequent to passing the principles and practices of land surveying examination,
118	pass the board approved examination on the laws and history of land surveying in
119	Georgia, the Georgia Professional Land Surveyor examination;
120	(E) Acquire not less than eight years of combined office and field experience in land
121	surveying of a nature satisfactory to the board; and

- 122 (F) When the requirements of subparagraphs (A) through (E) of this paragraph have
- 123 been satisfied, the applicant will be eligible for licensure as a professional land
- 124 <u>surveyor.</u>"

125 **SECTION 4.**

- 126 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025.

- 128 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
