## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 37-2-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Behavioral Health Coordinating Council, membership, meetings, and obligations, so as to
- 3 add the commissioner of veterans service as a member of such council; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 37-2-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Behavioral
- 8 Health Coordinating Council, membership, meetings, and obligations, is amended by
- 9 revising subsections (a) and (h) as follows:

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- 11 (a) There is created the Behavioral Health Coordinating Council. The council shall consist
- of the commissioner of behavioral health and developmental disabilities; the commissioner
- of early care and learning; the commissioner of community health; the commissioner of
- public health; the commissioner of human services; the commissioner of juvenile justice;
- 15 the commissioner of corrections; the commissioner of veterans service; the commissioner
- of community supervision; the commissioner of community affairs; the commissioner of
- 17 the Technical College System of Georgia; the Commissioner of Labor; the State School

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18 Superintendent; the chairperson of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles; a behavioral 19 health expert employed by the University System of Georgia, designated by the chancellor 20 of the university system; two members, appointed by the Governor; the ombudsman 21 appointed pursuant to Code Section 37-2-32; the Child Advocate for the Protection of 22 Children; an expert on early childhood mental health, appointed by the Governor; an expert 23 on child and adolescent health, appointed by the Governor; a pediatrician, appointed by the 24 Governor; an adult consumer of public behavioral health services, appointed by the 25 Governor; a family member of a consumer of public behavioral health services, appointed 26 by the Governor; a parent of a child receiving public behavioral health services, appointed 27 by the Governor; a member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of 28 the House of Representatives; and a member of the Senate, appointed by the <del>Lieutenant</del> 29 Governor President of the Senate." 30 The council shall submit annual reports no later than October 1 of its ''(h)(1)31 recommendations and evaluation of its implementation and any recommendations for 32 funding to the Office of Health Strategy and Coordination, the Governor, the Speaker of
