## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to require that certain persons secure
- 3 a license in order to manufacture a firearm in this state; to provide for duties of the director
- 4 of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation; to provide for fees and rules and regulations; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "16-11-174.
- 12 (a) No person, other than a dealer, shall manufacture any firearm in this state unless he or
- she has registered with the director of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and received a
- 14 <u>license for such manufacture</u>. A license issued under this Code section shall be valid only
- 15 for the firearm identified for manufacturing.
- 16 (b)(1) The director of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation shall issue a license to a
- person pursuant to subsection (a) of this Code section only after submitting such person's
- information to NICS and finding that such person meets the requirements provided for
- in Code Section 16-11-129 for a weapons carry license.
- 20 (2) The director of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation is authorized to assess a fee for
- 21 <u>issuing a license under this Code section and to promulgate rules and regulations that he</u>
- or she deems necessary for the proper administration and enforcement of this Code
- 23 <u>section.</u>"

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
