A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 trafficking of persons for labor or sexual servitude, so as to provide for increased sentences
- 3 for persons convicted of trafficking a minor or a developmentally disabled person for sexual
- 4 servitude; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to provide for related matters;
- 5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-5-46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trafficking of 9 persons for labor or sexual servitude, is amended by revising subsection (f) as follows:
- "(f)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, any person who commits
 the offense of trafficking an individual for labor servitude or sexual servitude shall be
 guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for
 not less than ten nor more than 20 years and a fine not to exceed \$100,000.00.
 - (2)(A) Any person who commits the offense of trafficking an individual for labor servitude or sexual servitude against an individual who is under 18 years of age or if the offense is committed against an individual who has a developmental disability, the person shall be guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by

imprisonment for not less than 25 nor more than 50 years or life imprisonment and a fine not to exceed \$100,000.00.

- (B) Any person who commits the offense of trafficking an individual for sexual servitude against an individual who is under 18 years of age or if the offense is committed against an individual who has a developmental disability shall be guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for life or by a split sentence that is a term of imprisonment for not less than 30 years and not exceeding life imprisonment, followed by probation for life, and a fine not to exceed \$250,000.00. As a condition of probation, the court shall impose the requirement of electronic monitoring as set forth in paragraph (14) of subsection (a) of Code Section 42-8-35.
- 29 (3)(A) As used in this paragraph, the term 'sexual felony' shall have the same meaning as set forth in paragraph (2) of subsection (j) of Code Section 16-5-21.
 - (B) Any person having been previously convicted of a sexual felony who is convicted of the offense of trafficking of persons for sexual servitude shall be punished by imprisonment for life or a split sentence that is a term of imprisonment followed by probation for life. As a condition of probation, the court shall impose the requirement of electronic monitoring as set forth in paragraph (14) of subsection (a) of Code Section 42-8-35."
