A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 16-6-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
 penalties for violating Code Sections 16-6-9 through 16-6-12, so as to increase the penalty
 provisions relating to pimping and pandering; to provide for related matters; to repeal
 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

7 Code Section 16-6-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to penalties for
8 violating Code Sections 16-6-9 through 16-6-12, is amended by revising subsection (a) and
9 paragraph (2) of subsection (b) as follows:

10 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this Code section, a person
11 convicted of violating:

(1) Code Section 16-6-10 shall be punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and
aggravated nature, and at the sole discretion of the judge, all but 24 hours of any term of
imprisonment imposed may be suspended, stayed, or probated;

15 (2) Code Section 16-6-9 shall be punished as for a misdemeanor;

16 (3) Code Section 16-6-11 for a:

17 (A) First offense shall be punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated 18 nature, and at the sole discretion of the judge, all but 72 hours of any term of 19 imprisonment imposed may be suspended, stayed, or probated guilty of a felony and 20 shall be punished by a term of imprisonment of not less than one nor more than ten 21 vears: and 22 (B) Second or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by 23 a term of imprisonment of not less than one year nor more than ten years and shall be 24 sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of one year; provided, 25 however, that in the court's discretion, the court may depart from such mandatory 26 minimum sentence when the prosecuting attorney and defendant have agreed to a 27 sentence that is below such mandatory minimum; or 28 (4) Code Section 16-6-12 for a:

(A) First offense shall be punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated
nature, and at the sole discretion of the judge, all but 72 hours of any term of
imprisonment imposed may be suspended, stayed, or probated guilty of a felony and
shall be punished by a term of imprisonment of not less than one nor more than ten
years; and

(B) Second or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by
a term of imprisonment of not less than one year nor more than ten years and shall be
sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of one year; provided,
however, that in the court's discretion, the court may depart from such mandatory
minimum sentence when the prosecuting attorney and defendant have agreed to a
sentence that is below such mandatory minimum."
40 "(2) A person convicted of any of the offenses enumerated in Code Sections 16-6-10

through 16-6-12 when such offense involves the conduct of a person under the age of 18
years shall for a:

- 43 (A) First offense shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment for a period of not less than ten nor more than 30 years and a fine of not more than 44 \$100,000.00; and 45 (B) Second or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by 46 47 imprisonment for a period of not less than ten nor more than 30 years and a fine of not 48 more than \$100,000.00 and shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 49 imprisonment of one year; provided, however, that in the court's discretion, the court 50 may depart from such mandatory minimum sentence when the prosecuting attorney and 51 defendant have agreed to a sentence that is below such mandatory minimum; and
- 52 provided, further, that the mandatory minimum sentence provided for in this
- 53 <u>subparagraph shall not apply to the offenses enumerated in Code Section 16-6-10.</u>"
