A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to death investigations, so as to allow the chief medical examiner to inter and disinter
- 3 unidentified human remains under certain circumstances; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 death investigations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "45-16-51.
- 10 (a) The chief medical examiner shall be authorized to inter unidentified human remains
- after the peace officer in charge has exhausted all efforts in identifying such remains.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding Code Section 45-16-45, the chief medical examiner shall have the
- authority to disinter remains interred pursuant to subsection (a) of this Code section when
- 14 the chief medical examiner determines that further information can be obtained or further
- 15 testing can be performed that may result in the identification of such remains."

16 SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
