A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 10 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 and Article 4 of Chapter 91 of Title 36 of the
- 2 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to contracts and purchases by public schools
- 3 and bidding for government works projects, respectively, so as impose requirements on
- 4 certain contracts and purchases by local boards of education; to require that professional
- 5 services contracts exceeding \$50,000.00 be competitively bid; to require that the guaranteed
- 6 maximum price submitted by a construction manager at risk to a local board of education not
- 7 be changed after execution of a contract; to provide for related matters; to provide for
- 8 applicability and an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 11 Article 10 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 12 contracts and purchases by public schools, is amended by revising Code Section 20-2-501,
- 13 which is reserved, as follows:
- 14 "20-2-501.

- 15 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this Code section, local boards of
- education shall provide that all contracts for professional services exceeding \$50,000.00
- 17 over a 12 month period shall be awarded by competitive sealed bidding.
- 18 (b) A local board of education shall not be required to comply with subsection (a) of this
- 19 Code section if such local board deems, by majority vote, that the professional services to
- be procured are unique and can only be obtained from a single source. Such determination
- 21 by the local board shall be subject to judicial review by filing an appeal in the superior
- 22 court of the county in which the local board of education is located.
- 23 (c) The State Board of Education shall be authorized to establish regulations and
- 24 procedures to implement the provisions of this Code section.

SECTION 2.

- 27 Article 4 of Chapter 91 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 28 bidding for government works projects, is amended by adding a new Code section to read
- 29 as follows:
- 30 "<u>36-91-103.</u>
- 31 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'construction manager at risk' means a
- 32 <u>construction delivery method that allows the owner to:</u>
- 33 (1) Hire a construction manager at any time during the project predesign phase where the
- 34 <u>construction manager works with the architect and engineer to develop and estimate costs</u>
- 35 <u>for the design and a guaranteed maximum price is provided by the construction manager</u>
- at risk who then receives proposals and awards contracts to subcontractors; or
- 37 (2) Hire a general contractor after the completion of the design phase.
- 38 (b) A local board of education that selects a construction manager at risk pursuant to a
- 39 competitive procurement process in accordance with this article shall require that the
- 40 guaranteed maximum price provided by such construction manager at risk shall not be
- 41 <u>subject to change after the contract between the local board of education and the</u>
- 42 <u>construction manager at risk is executed."</u>

43 SECTION 3.

- 44 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014, and shall apply to all procurements and
- 45 competitive sealed bids and sealed proposals submitted by a bidder or offeror for a public
- 46 works construction project by a local board of education on and after such date.

47 SECTION 4.

48 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
