## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to revenue and taxation, so as to provide for the establishment of
- 3 a website to provide taxpayers of this state with an itemized estimated receipt showing how
- 4 the taxes they pay are utilized; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date;
- 5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions relative to revenue and taxation, is amended by adding a new Code section to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 "<u>48-1-11.</u>
- 12 (a) This Act shall be known and may be cited as the 'Georgia Taxpayer Receipt Act of
- 13 2013.'
- 14 (b) It is the public policy of this state to ensure that taxpayers' dollars are spent in a
- 15 responsible manner and to encourage the citizens of this state to be well informed about the
- workings of their state government. It is the purpose of this Code section to provide a
- 17 <u>mechanism whereby every Georgian can access a simple and fair estimate of how their</u>
- state tax dollars are actually spent.
- 19 (c) On or before January 1, 2014, the commissioner shall establish a website that allows
- 20 Georgia taxpayers to obtain an estimated receipt itemizing the areas in which taxpayers'
- 21 Georgia state income taxes and state sales taxes were spent. The commissioner shall
- 22 promulgate necessary rules and regulations to outline the features to be incorporated into
- 23 the website and the procedures to be followed in developing and maintaining the website.
- 24 Prior to publication, regulations promulgated under the authority of this Code section shall
- 25 <u>be approved by majority vote at a joint meeting of the Senate Government Oversight and</u>
- 26 <u>the House Budget and Fiscal Affairs Oversight committees."</u>

**SECTION 2.** 

- 28 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 29 without such approval.

30 **SECTION 3.** 

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
