A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to motor vehicle certificates of title, so as to exempt a surviving spouse from motor
- 3 vehicle certificate of title application fees when such spouse is removing a decedent joint
- 4 owner from a certificate of title; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 motor vehicle certificates of title, is amended by revising Code Section 40-3-38, relating to
- 10 application fees, as follows:
- 11 "40-3-38.
- 12 (a) An application for a certificate of title shall be accompanied by the required fee when
- mailed or delivered to the commissioner or a designated agent.
- 14 (b) An application for the naming of a lienholder on a certificate of title shall be
- accompanied by the required fee when mailed or delivered to the commissioner or a
- designated agent.
- 17 (c) The commissioner shall be paid a fee of \$18.00 for the filing of an application for any
- certificate of title and for the filing of the notice of a security interest or a lien on vehicles
- 19 not required by law to be titled in this state. The commissioner may, by appropriate
- 20 regulation, provide for additional fees not to exceed \$18.00 for the special handling of
- 21 applications for certificates of title and related documents. The commissioner shall be paid
- a fee of \$8.00 for the filing of an application for a replacement certificate of title. The fee
- for issuance of a replacement certificate of title shall be the same whether mailed or
- 24 delivered to the commissioner or an agent.

25 (d) The above fees shall be required of all applicants except the State of Georgia, and the

- 26 United States of America, and a surviving spouse upon application for a certificate of title
- 27 which removes a decedent joint owner upon the death of the decedent spouse."

28 SECTION 2.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
