A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act,"
- 3 so as to prohibit the assignment of graded homework for students in grades kindergarten
- 4 through two; to provide for a short title; to provide for a definition; to provide for exceptions;
- 5 to provide for statutory construction; provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 6 and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "After School Recess Act."

SECTION 2.

- 11 Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 12 relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended
- 13 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 "<u>20-2-323.1.</u>
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'graded homework' means any work assigned to
- 16 <u>a student that is to be completed in whole or in part beyond the regular school day and that</u>
- 17 <u>will be part of the student's overall grade for the course.</u> For purposes of this Code section,
- 18 <u>homework shall be deemed graded if it is to be reviewed by a teacher or other school</u>
- 19 personnel and assessed with a letter grade, a percentage grade, a number grade, or on the
- 20 <u>basis of 'pass or fail' or 'complete or incomplete.' If a student's failure to complete or turn</u>
- 21 <u>in a homework assignment will have any negative impact on the student's overall grade in</u>
- 22 <u>the course, result in disciplinary consequences, result in a reduced time for recess or other</u>
- 23 <u>noninstructional activities, or result in reduced privileges, then the homework shall be</u>
- deemed graded.

25 (b) All elementary schools which receive in any manner funds from the state shall prohibit

- 26 the assignment of graded homework for students in grades kindergarten through two, with
- 27 <u>exceptions made, as deemed appropriate by the local school system, for the following for</u>
- 28 <u>students who are assigned graded homework as part of:</u>
- 29 (1) Special education services provided pursuant to Code Section 20-2-152;
- 30 (2) An early intervention program as described in Code Section 20-2-153;
- 31 (3) A program for limited-English-proficient students as described in Code Section
- 32 <u>20-2-156;</u>
- 33 (4) An Individualized Education Program under the federal Individuals with Disabilities
- 34 Education Act; and
- 35 (5) A Section 504 Plan under the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
- 36 (c) This Code section shall be construed to be a statute relating to the protection of the
- 37 physical health and safety of school students for purposes of subsection (e) of Code Section
- 38 <u>20-2-82</u>, subsection (b) of Code Section 20-2-244, and paragraph (5) of subsection (b) of
- 39 <u>Code Section 20-2-2065.</u>"

41 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
