

The Senate Committee on Public Safety offered the following substitute to SB 400:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 special license plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit  
3 corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit  
4 corporation, so as to establish a specialty license plate supporting the advocacy and  
5 promotion of strict interpretation of the United States Constitution with a portion of funds  
6 collected to be disbursed to the Foundation for Moral Law, Inc.; to provide for related  
7 matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide for compliance with constitutional  
8 requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 **SECTION 1.**

11 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license  
12 plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations with  
13 proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation, is  
14 amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:

15 “(71) A special license plate supporting the advocacy and promotion of strict  
16 interpretation of the United States Constitution. The funds raised by the sale of this  
17 special license plate shall be disbursed to the Foundation for Moral Law, Inc.”

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the  
22 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the  
23 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

24 **SECTION 4.**

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
