17	to operating the vessel. The department shall notify any individual who registers a vessel
18	for the first time, as indicated in the department's active electronic registration system,
19	of this requirement. Any individual who executes a sworn statement attesting that he or
20	she has regularly operated motorized vessels for ten or more years shall be exempt from
21	this requirement."
