## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to provide a
- 3 standard by which state, county, and local law enforcement agencies authorize the
- 4 engagement of vehicular pursuits; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 5 and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions relative to law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by revising Code
- 10 Section 35-1-14, relating to written policies for emergency pursuits, as follows:
- 11 "35-1-14.
- 12 (a) On and after January 1, 2004, each Each state, county, and local law enforcement
- agency that conducts emergency response and vehicular pursuits shall adopt written
- policies, consistent with this Code section, that set forth the manner in which these
- operations shall be conducted. Each law enforcement agency may create its own such
- policies or adopt an existing model, consistent with this Code section. All pursuit policies
- 17 created or adopted by any law enforcement agency must address situations in which police
- pursuits cross over into other jurisdictions. Law enforcement agencies which do not
- comply with the requirements of this Code section are subject to the withholding of any
- state funding or state administered federal funding.
- 21 (b) No state, county, or local law enforcement agency shall authorize the engagement of
- 22 <u>a vehicular pursuit unless:</u>
- 23 (1) The requirements of Code Section 40-6-6 are met; and
- 24 (2) Probable cause exists to believe that the persons being pursued committed, or are
- 25 <u>committing, murder as provided for in Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 16; aggravated</u>
- 26 <u>battery as provided for in Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 16; kidnapping, false</u>

27	imprisonment, or any other offense as provided for in Article 3 of Chapter 5 of Title 16;
28	rape as provided for in Chapter 6 of Title 16; armed robbery as provided for in Article 2
29	of Chapter 8 of Title 16; or any offense that creates an immediate threat of death or
30	serious bodily injury to another person or a substantial threat to the safety of another
31	person."

## 32 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 33
