2	"(e) The director, subject to the direction and control of the Governor, shall:
3	(1) Be be the executive head of the Georgia Emergency Management Agency and shall
4	be responsible to the Governor for carrying out the program for emergency management
5	in this state. He or she shall coordinate;
6	(2) Serve as the central authority reporting to the Governor on all matters relating to
7	homeland security;
8	(3) Have command and control authority over all operational areas involving terrorist
9	activity within this state, including, but not limited to, command and control over all task
10	forces and central commands related thereto;
11	(4) Coordinate the activities of all organizations for emergency management and
12	homeland security within the state, shall maintain;
13	(5) Maintain liaison with and cooperate with emergency management agencies and
14	organizations of other states and of the federal government;
15	(6) Oversee all risk and threat assessments and coordinate all plans for timely and
16	complete responses through a network of federal, state, and local organizations,
17	including, but not limited to, coordination of the efficient and timely flow of information;
18	(7) Be responsible for crisis and consequence management planning, including, but not
19	limited to, measures to identify, acquire, and plan the use of resources needed to
20	anticipate, prevent, or resolve a threat or act of terrorism;
21	(8) Coordinate and review all activities involving homeland security within any agency,
22	authority, or entity of this state, including, but not limited to, oversight of homeland
23	security activities found within the Department of Public Safety, the Georgia Bureau of
24	Investigation, the Georgia National Guard, the Department of Natural Resources, the
25	Department of Community Health, and the Department of Public Health;
26	(9) Evaluate information developed by the criminal justice community in regard to
27	threats or potential threats of terrorism; and
28	(10) Have shall have such additional authority, duties, and responsibilities authorized by
29	Article 1, this article, and Article 3 of this chapter as may be prescribed by the Governor
30	and such additional authority, duties, and responsibilities as described in Article 9 of
31	Chapter 3 of Title 35 and Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 46, the 'Georgia
32	Emergency Telephone Number 9-1-1 Service Act of 1977,' as amended."
