A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 26-4-80.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the use of security paper for hard copy prescription drug orders, so as to change provisions relating to filling Schedule II controlled substance prescriptions; to provide for record keeping; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1. 6 7 Code Section 26-4-80.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to use of security 8 paper for hard copy prescription drug orders, is amended by revising subsection (b) as 9 follows: 10 "(b) A pharmacist shall not fill a hard copy prescription drug order for any Schedule II 11 controlled substance from a practitioner unless: 12 (1) It it is written on security paper, except that a pharmacist may provide emergency 13 supplies in accordance with the board and other insurance contract requirements; and 14 (2) The individual providing such prescription provides the pharmacist with his or her 15 government issued identification containing the individual's name, address, and 16 photograph and the pharmacist photocopies such identification. The pharmacist shall retain such photocopy for a minimum of three years." 17
