AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 22 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 clinical laboratories, so as to provide for changes to provisions exempting pharmacists from 3 provisions of said chapter when performing certain tests; to remove a cross-reference; to 4 provide for reporting of tests and standards; to provide for related matters; to repeal 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Chapter 22 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to clinical laboratories, is amended in Code Section 31-22-9, relating to applicability of chapter, by 9 10 revising subsection (b) as follows: 11 (b) This chapter shall not apply to pharmacists licensed pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 26 12 practicing in accordance with the provisions thereof, who shall be considered practicing 13 within their scope of practice, when they are performing capillary blood tests and 14 interpreting the results as a means to screen for or monitor disease risk factors or drug use 15 and facilitate patient education as authorized in Code Section 26-4-4, so long as such 16 capillary blood tests are available to and for use by the public without licensure of the user 17 of the test such tests. Pharmacists performing such tests shall make reasonable efforts to 18 report the results obtained from such tests to the patient's physician of choice."

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SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.

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
