A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 uniform rules of the road, so as to revise the criminal penalty for operating a vehicle without
- 3 adequately securing load; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to uniform rules
- 8 of the road, is amended by revising Code Section 40-6-254, relating to operating vehicle
- 9 without adequately securing load, as follows:
- 10 "40-6-254.
- No person shall operate any motor vehicle with a load on or in such vehicle unless the load
- on or in such vehicle is adequately secured to prevent the dropping or shifting of such load
- onto the roadway in such a manner as to create a safety hazard. For purposes of this Code
- section, a load shall include, but not be limited to, a trailer required to be registered under
- 15 Chapter 2 of this title. Any person who operates a vehicle in violation of this Code section
- shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
