A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-1185 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 7 Code Section 20-2-1185 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to school safety
- 8 plans, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) Every public school and private school shall prepare a school safety plan and conduct
- drills to help curb the growing incidence of violence in schools, to respond effectively to
- such incidents, and to provide a safe learning environment for Georgia's children, teachers,
- and other school personnel. Such plan shall also address preparedness for natural disasters,
- hazardous materials or radiological accidents, acts of violence, and acts of terrorism.
- School safety plans of public <u>and private</u> schools shall be prepared with input from students
- enrolled in that school, parents or legal guardians of such students, teachers in that school,
- 16 community leaders, other school employees and school district employees, and local law
- enforcement, fire service, public safety, and emergency management agencies. School
- safety plans of private schools may be prepared with input from students enrolled in that

school, parents or legal guardians of such students, teachers in that school, other school

- 20 employees, and local law enforcement, fire service, public safety, and emergency
- 21 management agencies. Such plans shall be reviewed and, if necessary, updated annually.
- 22 Such plans of public and private schools shall be submitted to the local emergency
- 23 management agency."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
