A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to handicapped persons, so as to provide for real-time captioning
- 3 of legislative proceedings for the deaf and hearing impaired; to provide for definitions; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions relative to handicapped persons, is amended by adding a new Code section to read
- 9 as follows:

- 10 "30-1-7.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 12 (1) 'Captioning' means the process of converting the audio content of a broadcast into
- text and displaying words as the textual equivalent of spoken dialogue or narration and
- includes speaker identification, sound effects, and music description. Captions are
- synchronized, appear at approximately the same time as the audio is delivered, and are
- equivalent and equal in content to that of the audio, including speaker identification and
- sound effects. When displayed, captions shall be in the same line of sight as any
- corresponding visual information, such as video, speaker, field of play, activity, or
- 19 <u>exhibition</u>.
- 20 (2) 'Hearing impaired person' means any person who, absent the aid of a hearing device,
- 21 <u>has any degree of impairment in the ability to apprehend sound.</u>
- 22 (3) 'Real-time captions' means captions provided for live presentations.
- 23 (b) Pursuant to the policy of the State of Georgia to secure the rights of deaf and hearing
- 24 <u>impaired persons who cannot readily understand and equally participate in or benefit from</u>
- 25 <u>the activities of this state's legislative body, the General Assembly shall provide or cause</u>
- 26 to be provided real-time captions for the benefit of deaf and hearing impaired persons of

- 27 <u>any House of Representatives and Senate standing committee meetings and any other live</u>
- 28 public broadcasts provided by or on behalf of the General Assembly for public viewing."

SECTION 2.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
