A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 10 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Board of Health Care Workforce, so as to provide for the establishment of the
- 3 Georgia Health Care Professionals Data System; to provide for definitions; to provide for
- 4 collaboration with state licensing boards; to provide for a publicly accessible website; to
- 5 provide for collection of data from state licensing boards; to provide for specified data; to
- 6 provide for seeking of funding sources; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Chapter 10 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 11 Board of Health Care Workforce, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 "49-10-7.
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Licensed health care professional' means the following health care professionals
- licensed or certified by a state licensing board:

17 (A) Physicians, acupuncturists, physician assistants, respiratory care professionals,

- clinical perfusionists, orthotists, prosthetists, cosmetic laser practitioners, and genetic
- 19 <u>counselors</u>;
- 20 (B) Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians;
- 21 (C) Dentists and dental hygienists;
- 22 (D) Chiropractors;
- 23 (E) Optometrists;
- 24 (F) Occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants;
- 25 (G) Physical therapists and physical therapist assistants;
- 26 (H) Audiologists and speech-language pathologists;
- 27 <u>(I) Psychologists;</u>
- 28 (J) Licensed practical nurses, registered professional nurses, and advanced practice
- 29 <u>registered nurses, including certified nurse midwives, nurse practitioners, certified</u>
- 30 <u>registered nurse anesthetists, and clinical nurse specialists in psychiatric/mental health;</u>
- 31 (K) Emergency medical technicians, paramedics, and cardiac technicians;
- 32 (L) Podiatrists;
- 33 (M) Dietitians; and
- 34 (N) Professional counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists.
- 35 (2) 'State licensing board' means:
- 36 (A) Georgia Composite Medical Board;
- 37 (B) State Board of Pharmacy;
- 38 (C) Georgia Board of Dentistry;
- 39 (D) Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners;
- 40 (E) State Board of Optometry;
- 41 (F) State Board of Occupational Therapy;
- 42 (G) State Board of Physical Therapy;
- 43 (H) State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology;

- 44 (I) State Board of Examiners of Psychologists;
- 45 (J) Georgia Board of Nursing;
- 46 (K) Department of Public Health;
- 47 (L) State Board of Podiatry Examiners;
- 48 (M) Georgia Board of Examiners of Licensed Dietitians; and
- 49 (N) Georgia Composite Board of Professional Counselors, Social Workers, and
- Marriage and Family Therapists.
- 51 (b) In collaboration with state licensing boards, the board shall create and maintain the
- 52 Georgia Health Care Professionals Data System for the purposes of collecting and
- disseminating nonidentifying descriptive data on licensed health care professionals in this
- state. The board shall compile existing information on licensed health care professionals
- 55 into a single repository of information easily accessible to the public from the board's
- 56 website. The data system shall provide information to the public regarding the
- 57 <u>demographics and geographical distribution of licensed health care professionals in this</u>
- 58 state. The data system shall contain no individually identifying information regarding any
- 59 licensed health care professional.
- 60 (c) State licensing boards shall provide the data contained in subsection (d) of this Code
- section upon request by the board or up to two times annually as required by the board.
- The board shall work with state licensing boards regarding the manner, form, and content
- for the reporting of such data. The board shall be authorized to enter into memoranda of
- agreement with individual state licensing boards for purposes of data transmission criteria
- pursuant to this Code section.
- 66 (d) State licensing boards shall provide the following data to the board for its licensed
- health care professionals who are in active practice:
- 68 <u>(1)</u> Age;
- 69 (2) Race;
- 70 (3) Gender;

- 71 (4) Ethnicity;
- 72 (5) Location of practice; and
- 73 (6) License type.
- 74 (e) The board shall be authorized to seek federal or other sources of funding necessary to
- 75 support the creation and maintenance of the Georgia Health Care Professionals Data
- 76 <u>System.</u>"
- 77 SECTION 2.
- 78 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
