

Senate Bill 488

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to hunting, so as to provide that any  
3 licensee 80 years of age or older who did not obtain the full 2019 turkey gobbler bag limit  
4 may rollover the remaining number of such limit to the 2020 turkey hunting season; to  
5 provide for an automatic repealer; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;  
6 and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
10 relating to general provisions relative to hunting, is amended by adding a new Code section  
11 to read as follows:

12 "27-3-15.1.

13 Any licensee 80 years of age or older who obtained a big game license for the 2019 turkey  
14 hunting season and who did not reach the turkey gobbler bag limit for such species hunting  
15 season, as prescribed in subsection (b) of Code Section 27-3-15, may rollover any  
16 remaining number of the 2019 bag limit to the 2020 hunting season for same such species."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Code section shall stand repealed by operation of law on December 31, 2020.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
