

The Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism offered the following substitute to SB 5:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 52-2-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general powers of the Georgia Ports Authority, so as to provide for powers of the authority
3 with respect to acceptance of loans or grants from the United States upon certain terms and
4 conditions; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

7 This Act is enacted pursuant to Article III, Section VI, Paragraph II(a)(3) of the Constitution
8 of Georgia.

SECTION 2.

10 Code Section 52-2-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general powers
11 of the Georgia Ports Authority, is amended by revising paragraph (7) as follows:

13 "(7) To accept loans and grants, either or both, of money or materials or property of any
14 kind from the United States of America or any agency or instrumentality thereof upon
15 such terms and conditions as the United States of America or such agency or
16 instrumentality may impose and to comply with such terms and conditions; including but
17 not limited to the power to provide indemnification on behalf of the authority or any other
18 agency or instrumentality of the state if such other agency or instrumentality be an equal
19 participant with the authority as a non-federal sponsor of a congressionally authorized
20 civil works project for the benefit of the United States of America or any agency or
21 instrumentality thereof, which power has existed since the creation of the authority;"

SECTION 3.

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
23 without such approval.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
