## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 9 of Chapter 7 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to hospice care, so as to provide that hospice administrators are not required to be
- 3 health care professionals or trained in health services administration; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
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- 7 Article 9 of Chapter 7 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 hospice care, is amended by revising Code Section 31-7-175, relating to administration of
- 9 such article, as follows:
- 10 "31-7-175.
- 11 (a) The administration of this article is vested in the Department of Community Health
- which shall:
- 13 (1) Prepare and furnish all forms necessary under the provisions of this article in relation
- to the application for licensure or renewals thereof;
- 15 (2) After consultation with appropriate public interest groups, adopt rules within the
- standards of this article necessary to effect the purposes of this article; and
- 17 (3) Establish comprehensive rules and regulations for the licensure of hospices.
- 18 (b) Rules promulgated by the department shall include but not be limited to the following:
- 19 (1) The qualifications of professional and ancillary personnel in order to furnish adequate
- 20 hospice care; provided, however, that the department shall not require that the hospice
- 21 <u>administrator be a licensed health care professional or an individual with education,</u>
- training, and experience in health services administration;
- 23 (2) Comprehensive standards for the organization and quality of patient care;
- 24 (3) Procedures for maintaining records;
- 25 (4) Comprehensive standards for inpatient facilities, to include specifications that the
- 26 hospice retain primary responsibility for the coordination of inpatient hospice care;

27 (5) Provision for contractual arrangements for professional and ancillary hospice

- services; and
- 29 (6) Provisions for the imposition of administrative fines for any violations of any
- provisions of this article or of department rules or regulations."

## **SECTION 2.**

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
