## AS PASSED SENATE

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 18 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to solicitors-general of state courts, so as to provide for the honorary office of
- 3 solicitor-general emeritus; to provide for qualifications; to provide for certificate; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 3 of Chapter 18 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 solicitors-general of state courts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 9 follows:

- 10 "15-18-75.
- 11 (a) There is created the honorary office of solicitor-general emeritus of the State of
- 12 Georgia. Any solicitor-general of the state court of this state who retires under honorable
- 13 conditions after having served as a prosecuting attorney for 20 or more years shall
- 14 <u>automatically hold the honorary office of solicitor-general emeritus of the State of Georgia.</u>

15 (b) Any person holding the honorary office of solicitor-general emeritus of the State of

- 16 Georgia shall, upon application to the Secretary of State, be issued a special certificate
- 17 evidencing such honorary office.
- 18 (c) The honorary office of solicitor-general emeritus of the State of Georgia shall not
- 19 constitute the holding of public office or public employment for the purpose of any other
- 20 <u>law of this state, and there shall not be a salary or retirement benefit associated with the</u>
- 21 office.
- 22 (d) The provisions of this Code section shall not apply to or affect the provisions of
- 23 <u>Title 47.</u>"

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
