A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding eligibility and qualifications for office, so as to
- 3 provide for legislative findings; to provide that certain municipalities and counties may
- 4 require law enforcement officers employed by the municipality or county to reside within the
- 5 municipality or county; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 The General Assembly of Georgia finds that:
- 10 (1) In many areas of the state in larger cities and counties, citizens feel distant and
- 11 unconnected from the law enforcement officers who serve their communities;
- 12 (2) There should be more of a sense of community and a connection between law
- 13 enforcement officers and the communities in which they serve;
- 14 (3) Community oriented policing services have been effective in many areas, where they
- 15 have been implemented, by uniting the law enforcement officers with the communities in
- which they serve in a collaborative effort to prevent crime and protect the public;
- 17 (4) It would facilitate a greater connection with the community if law enforcement officers
- were actual residents of the area in which they serve;
- 19 (5) While requiring residence in the city or county in smaller jurisdictions may not be
- 20 feasible, such is not the case in larger jurisdictions;
- 21 (6) Residing in the community in which they serve would cause law enforcement officers
- 22 to engage the public at all levels and be a part of the fabric of the community; and
- 23 (7) Residing in the community in which they serve would also reduce response time to
- 24 emergency situations that arise in the community, as well as provide an off-duty law
- 25 enforcement presence in the community to deter crime.

26 SECTION 2.

- 27 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 28 general provisions regarding eligibility and qualifications for office, is amended by revising
- 29 Code Section 45-2-5, relating to municipal or county governments not to require residence
- 30 as condition of employment, as follows:
- 31 "45-2-5.
- 32 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this Code section, no No municipal or county
- 33 government in this state shall require as a condition of employment by such government
- 34 that applicants for employment as officers or employees, or such officers or employees
- 35 now or hereafter employed, must reside within the boundaries of the municipality or
- 36 county.
- 37 (b) In cities with a population of 50,000 or more persons or counties with a population of
- 38 150,000 or more persons in the most recent United States decennial census, a municipal or
- 39 county government may require as a condition of employment or continued employment
- 40 as a law enforcement officer that law enforcement officers reside within the boundaries of
- 41 the municipality or county."
- 42 SECTION 3.
- 43 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 44 without such approval.
- 45 **SECTION 4.**
- 46 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
