## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from sales and use taxes, so as to exempt sales of clothing and school related
- 3 supplies for limited periods of time; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
 sales and use taxes, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (75) as follows:
 "(75)(A) The sale of eligible property. The exemption provided by this paragraph
 applies only to sales occurring during the period commencing at 12:01 A.M. on July 30,
 August 2, 2024, and concluding at 12:00 Midnight on July 31, 2016 August 3,
 2024, and to sales occurring during the period commencing at 12:01 A.M. on March

29, 2025, and concluding at 12:00 Midnight on March 30, 2025."

- 15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
