## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections and primaries generally, so as to require certain fraud countermeasures on physical
- 3 absentee ballots; to provide an exception; to provide for rule making by the State Election
- 4 Board; to provide that such ballots shall be required only in the event of a specific
- 5 appropriation of funds by the General Assembly; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 6 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
- 10 primaries generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "21-2-391.
- 12 (a) Other than ballots delivered electronically to qualified electors who are entitled to vote
- by absentee ballot under the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting
- 14 Act, 52 U.S.C. Section 20301, et seq., whenever a physical absentee ballot is used pursuant
- 15 to this chapter, such ballot shall meet the requirements of this Code section.

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16 (b) Absentee ballots shall be printed on unique, controlled-supply security paper that

- 17 <u>incorporates features which can be used to authenticate the ballot as an official ballot, but</u>
- which do not make the ballot identifiable to a particular elector. Such security paper shall
- 19 <u>have at least one watermark revealed by black light and include a serial number that shall</u>
- 20 <u>individually identify each sheet of security paper.</u>
- 21 (c) The State Election Board shall be authorized to promulgate rules, regulations, and
- 22 procedures to implement and administer the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this
- 23 <u>Code section</u>.
- 24 (d) Election superintendents shall only be obligated to obtain the ballots required by this
- 25 Code section if, for the applicable year, the General Assembly appropriates funds to the
- 26 office of the Secretary of State in amounts sufficient for such office to reimburse each
- 27 election superintendent, county, or municipality for the costs of acquiring the ballots and
- 28 associated equipment provided for in this Code section."
- SECTION 2.
- 30 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 31 without such approval.
- 32 SECTION 3.
- 33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
