BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 2 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to competencies and core curriculum, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Code
- 10 Section 20-2-149.1, relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and use of
- automated external defibrillator and requirements, as follows:
- 12 "(c) Beginning in the 2013-2014 2022-2023 school year, each local board of education
- which operates a school with grades nine through 12 shall provide instruction in
- cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator and not
- 15 <u>less than one hour of instruction in first-aid</u> to its students <u>in grades nine or ten</u> as a
- requirement within existing health or physical education courses. Such training shall

include either of the following and shall incorporate into the instruction the psychomotor skills necessary to perform <u>first aid</u>, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and use an automated

- 19 external defibrillator:
- 20 (1) An instructional program developed by the American Heart Association or the
- 21 American Red Cross; or
- 22 (2) An instructional program which is nationally recognized and is based on the most
- current national evidence based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines for <u>first aid</u>,
- cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and the use of an automated external defibrillator."

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
