## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to designate the Sunday following Veterans Day each year
- 3 as "National Warrior Call Day" in Georgia; to provide for recognition of the tragically high
- 4 rate of suicides among service members and veterans; to encourage community outreach to
- 5 such persons; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 8 SECTION 1.
- 9 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 10 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>1-4-27.</u>
- 12 (a) The General Assembly recognizes that:
- 13 (1) Many veterans are dangerously disconnected from family, friends, and support
- 14 <u>systems;</u>

15 (2) Pandemics can lead to increased isolation and disconnection, further exacerbating

- mental and physical ailments such as post-traumatic stress disorder and traumatic brain
- 17 <u>injury;</u>
- 18 (3) There is a tragically high rate of suicide among service members and veterans of the
- 19 <u>United States military; and</u>
- 20 (4) Many of the veterans who take their own lives have had little or no contact with the
- 21 United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 22 (b) All residents of this state are encouraged to contact current service members and
- veterans, inform them that their service is appreciated, and, if needed, connect such persons
- 24 <u>to mental health or other support services.</u>
- 25 (c) The Sunday following Veterans Day each year is designated as 'National Warrior Call
- 26 <u>Day' in Georgia.</u>"
- 27 SECTION 2.
- 28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
