A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 mandatory education for children between ages six and 16, so as to provide a short title; to
- 3 change the ages of mandatory education; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Universal Kindergarten Mandate For Early
- 7 Starts Act."
- 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mandatory
- 10 education for children between ages six and 16, is amended by revising subsection (a) as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "(a) Mandatory attendance in a public school, private school, or home school program shall
- be required for children between their sixth fifth and sixteenth birthdays. Such mandatory
- attendance shall not be required where the child is not eligible for enrollment under Code
- 15 <u>Section 20-2-150 or</u> has successfully completed all requirements for a high school
- 16 diploma."
- SECTION 3.
- 18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
