A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act creating a new judicial circuit for the State of Georgia to be known as the 1 2 Alcovy Judicial Circuit, approved March 9, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 152), as amended, 3 particularly by an Act approved March 30, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 1217), so as to authorize 4 the counties that make up said judicial circuit to provide additional investigators to the 5 district attorney; to provide for appointment and qualifications of such investigators; to 6 provide for the powers of such investigators; to provide that such investigators shall serve 7 at the pleasure of the district attorney; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting 8 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

To amend an Act creating a new judicial circuit for the State of Georgia to be known as the
Alcovy Judicial Circuit, approved March 9, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 152), as amended,
particularly by an Act approved March 30, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 1217), is amended by
revising Section 4A as follows:

15	"SECTION 4A.
16	The governing authorities of Newton County and Walton County are authorized, but not
17	required, to provide for the employment of investigators by the district attorney for the
18	Alcovy Judicial Circuit. Any investigator appointed pursuant to this Act or Code
19	Section 15-18-14.1 of the O.C.G.A. shall meet the qualifications for certification as a peace
20	officer as provided in Chapter 8 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia, the 'Georgia
21	Peace Officer Standards and Training Act.' Such investigators shall exercise all the powers
22	of a peace officer including the power to make arrests and to apply for, execute, and return
23	any warrant, rule, order, or process in any county of this state. Said investigators shall
24	further be considered police officers pursuant to subparagraph (c)(2)(C) of Code
25	Section 16-11-130 of the O.C.G.A. Said investigators shall serve at the pleasure of the
26	district attorney."
