A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to wiretapping, eavesdropping, surveillance, and related offenses, so as to provide that it shall be legal to intercept a wire, oral, or electronic communication if all parties to the communication consent to such interception; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1. 8 Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 9 relating to wiretapping, eavesdropping, surveillance, and related offenses, is amended by 10 revising subsection (a) of Code Section 16-11-66, relating to interception of wire, oral, or 11 electronic communication by party thereto; consent requirements for recording and divulging 12 conversations to which child under 18 years is a party; and parental exception, as follows: 13 "(a) Nothing in Code Section 16-11-62 shall prohibit a person from intercepting a wire, 14 oral, or electronic communication where such person is a party to the communication or one when all of the parties to the communication has have given prior consent to such 15 16 interception."

SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
