A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 legislative services generally, so as to provide for two designated handicap office suites, one 3 for members of the Senate and one for members of the House of Representatives who have 4 disabilities, in the state capitol building; to provide for definitions; to provide for related 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Chapter 4 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to legislative
9	services generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
10	" <u>28-4-2.1.</u>
11	(a) As used in this Code section, the term:
12	(1) 'Appropriate authority' means the Legislative Services Committee, the Governor, the
13	Georgia Building Authority, or any other authority that has jurisdiction over the allotment
14	of space in the state capitol building.
15	(2) 'Handicap office suite' means an office suite that is accessible to individuals with
16	disabilities.

- 17 (b) There shall be designated, by the appropriate authority, two handicap office suites in
- 18 the state capitol building. One shall be designated for use by members of the Senate who
- 19 have disabilities, and the other shall be designated for members of the House of
- 20 <u>Representatives who have disabilities.</u>"
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
