## AS PASSED SENATE

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 9 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to access to medical cannabis, so as to provide for information to be provided to the
- 3 Medical Cannabis Commission Oversight Committee; to require the commission to issue
- 4 initial Class 1 and Class 2 production licenses by a date certain; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 9 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 access to medical cannabis, is amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section
- 10 16-12-207, relating to establishment of Medical Cannabis Commission Oversight
- 11 Committee, membership, inspections, provision of information, plan for accredited lab
- 12 testing, and patient and physician input, as follows:
- 13 "(b) The commission shall promptly provide any document or information requested by
- 14 the oversight committee that is in its possession, provided that the commission shall not
- 15 share documents containing data identifying individual patients or physicians, information
- 16 marked as trade secrets by applicants or licensees, information that in the view of the
- 17 commission would interfere with an ongoing licensing applicant selection process, or

- 18 information that in the judgment of the commission would create law enforcement or
- 19 security risks to the citizens of Georgia any information that would be exempt from public
- 20 <u>disclosure pursuant to Code Section 50-18-72 or pursuant to state or federal privacy laws.</u>"
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 Said article is further amended in Code Section 16-12-221, relating to contracts awarded
- 23 through bids or proposals, minimum contract terms and renewals, subcontracting, and giving
- 24 or receiving things of value limited, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 25 "(a.1) The commission shall issue initial licenses under this part on or before May 31,
- 26 2022."
- SECTION 3.
- 28 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 29 without such approval.
- 30 **SECTION 4.**
- 31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
