A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding animal protection, so as to prohibit persons convicted
- 3 of cruelty to animals after July 1, 2019, from obtaining pet animals; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 general provisions regarding animal protection, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>4-11-15.2.</u>
- 12 <u>It shall be unlawful for any person convicted, after July 1, 2019, of violating Code Section</u>
- 13 <u>16-12-4 to become the owner of any dog, cat, bird, fish, reptile, or other animal customarily</u>
- obtained as a pet in this state."
- 15 SECTION 2.
- 16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019, and shall apply to offenses which occur on
- or after such date. Any offense occurring before July 1, 2019, shall be governed by the law
- 18 in effect at the time of such offense.
- 19 SECTION 3.
- 20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
