A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4A of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Department of Juvenile Justice, so as to provide for confidentiality of information supplied
- 3 by certain children; to provide for penalties for a breach of confidentiality; to amend Code
- 4 Section 15-11-84 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sharing confidential
- 5 information between governmental agencies, so as to provide a cross-reference; to provide
- 6 for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 4A of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department
- of Juvenile Justice, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>49-4A-19.</u>
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'children' means children under the supervision
- of the department or committed to the department.
- 15 (b) The identity of children and the information provided by children who report abuses
- or wrongdoing in the juvenile justice system shall not be subject to disclosure pursuant to
- 17 Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 nor otherwise disclosed by officials or employees of the
- department except upon the written request of the child, or a representative of such child,
- 19 <u>who reported the abuse or wrongdoing.</u>
- 20 (c) Any official or employee who violates this Code section shall be subject to suspension
- 21 <u>or discharge.</u>
- 22 (d) At least annually, the commissioner shall issue a public report summarizing the number
- 23 of reports of abuse or wrongdoing received and the general nature of such reports."

25 Code Section 15-11-84 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sharing

- 26 confidential information between governmental agencies, is amended by revising subsection
- 27 (b) as follows:
- 28 "(b) Governmental entities and state, county, municipal, or consolidated government
- departments, boards, or agencies shall exchange with each other all information not held
- 30 as confidential pursuant to federal law and relating to a child which may aid a
- 31 governmental entity in the assessment, treatment, intervention, or rehabilitation of a child,
- notwithstanding Code Section 15-1-15 or 15-11-9.1, subsection (d) of Code Section
- 33 15-11-10, or Code Section 15-11-66.1, 15-11-75, 15-11-81, 15-11-82, 15-11-174,
- 34 20-2-751.2, 20-14-40, 24-12-10, 24-12-11, 24-12-20, 26-4-5, 26-4-80, 26-5-17, 31-5-5,
- 35 31-33-6, 37-1-53, 37-2-9.1, 42-5-36, 42-8-40, 42-8-106, <u>49-4A-19</u>, 49-5-40, 49-5-41,
- 36 49-5-41.1, 49-5-44, 49-5-45, 49-5-183, 49-5-184, 49-5-185, or 49-5-186, in order to serve
- 37 the best interest of the child. Information which is shared pursuant to this subsection shall
- not be utilized to assist in the prosecution of the child in juvenile court or superior court or
- 39 utilized to the detriment of the child."

40 SECTION 3.

- 41 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 42 without such approval.

44 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
