

Senate Bill 70

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 elections and primaries generally, so as to provide that a person who votes in a general
3 election for the office of United States Representative or United States Senator in another
4 state and subsequently moves to this state shall be ineligible to vote in a runoff for any such
5 offices in this state in the same election cycle; to provide for related matters; to repeal
6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
10 primaries generally, is amended in Code Section 21-2-216, relating to qualifications of
11 electors generally, reregistration of electors purged from list, eligibility of nonresidents who
12 vote in presidential elections, retention of qualification for standing as elector, evidence of
13 citizenship, and check of convicted felons and deceased persons databases, by adding a new
14 subsection to read as follows:

15 "(i) A person who votes in a general election for the office of United States Representative
16 or United States Senator in another state and subsequently moves to this state shall be
17 ineligible to vote in a runoff for any such offices in this state in the same election cycle."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
