## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections and primaries generally, so as to provide that a person who votes in a general
- 3 election for the office of United States Representative or United States Senator in another
- 4 state and subsequently moves to this state shall be ineligible to vote in a runoff for any such
- 5 offices in this state in the same election cycle; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
- primaries generally, is amended in Code Section 21-2-216, relating to qualifications of
- electors generally, reregistration of electors purged from list, eligibility of nonresidents who
- vote in presidential elections, retention of qualification for standing as elector, evidence of
- citizenship, and check of convicted felons and deceased persons databases, by adding a new
- 14 subsection to read as follows:

"(i) A person who votes in a general election for the office of United States Representative
 or United States Senator in another state and subsequently moves to this state shall be
 ineligible to vote in a runoff for any such offices in this state in the same election cycle."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
