## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections and primaries generally, so as to revise the ability of poll watchers at tabulating
- 3 centers to observe the vote counting process; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
- 8 primaries generally, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Code Section 21-2-408, relating
- 9 to poll watchers, designation, duties, removal for interference with election, reports by poll
- 10 watchers of infractions or irregularities, and ineligibility of candidates to serve as poll
- 11 watchers, as follows:

- 12 "(c) In counties or municipalities using direct recording electronic (DRE) voting systems
- or optical scanning voting systems, each political party may appoint two poll watchers in
- each primary or election, each political body may appoint two poll watchers in each
- election, each nonpartisan candidate may appoint one poll watcher in each nonpartisan
- election, and each independent candidate may appoint one poll watcher in each election to

serve in the locations designated by the superintendent within the tabulating center. Such designated locations shall include the check-in area, the computer room, the duplication area, and such other poll watchers shall be given access to all areas as the superintendent may deem necessary to the assurance of in the tabulating center where ballots and election results are being received and processed to ensure fair and honest procedures in the tabulating center. The election superintendent may restrict the movement and activities of poll watchers in the tabulating center in order to provide for the security of the ballots and returns and to prevent interference by poll watchers in the tabulating process, but such restrictions should be as minimal as possible. The poll watchers provided for in this subsection shall be appointed and serve in the same manner as other poll watchers."

SECTION 2.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
