A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 12 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 supervision and support of paupers, so as to provide for cremation as an alternative for
- 3 deceased indigents; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 12 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the supervision
- 8 and support of paupers, is amended by revising Code Section 36-12-5, relating to the
- 9 interment of deceased indigents, as follows:
- 10 "36-12-5.
- 11 (a) Whenever any person dies in this state and the decedent, his <u>or her</u> family, and his <u>or</u>
- 12 <u>her</u> immediate kindred are indigent and unable to provide for his the decedent's decent
- interment <u>or cremation</u>, the governing authority of the county wherein the death occurs
- shall make available from county funds a sum sufficient to provide a decent interment or
- cremation of the deceased indigent person or to reimburse such person as may have
- 16 expended the cost thereof voluntarily, the exact amount thereof to be determined by the
- governing authority of the county <u>but shall not exceed the lesser of the actual costs of</u>
- interment or cremation.
- 19 (b) The Department of Corrections is authorized to reimburse the governing authority of
- 20 the county where expenditures have been made in accordance with this Code section for
- 21 the burial <u>or cremation</u> of any inmate under the authority, jurisdiction, or control of the
- Department of Corrections; but in no case shall the governing authority of the county be
- entitled to reimbursement where the decedent was in the custody of a county correctional
- institution or other county correctional facility."

SECTION 2.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
