A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to general provisions regarding parent and child relationship generally, so as to 3 prohibit certain actions by an adult acting in loco parentis with respect to child privacy; to 4 provide for definitions; to prohibit providing to, obtaining from, or discussing with a child 5 information of a sensitive nature except under certain conditions; to amend Part 3 of Article 6 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to student 7 health, so as to provide for a student's legal name in the official school record; to provide for 8 requirements relating to changing a student's gender in the official school record; to prohibit 9 the modification of a child's official school record with respect to gender without consent of 10 the child's parents or legal guardians; to prohibit engaging in instruction of a child when 11 dressed in a specific manner; to provide for applicability; to provide for violations; to provide 12 for related matters; to provide for a short title; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other 13 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

16 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Parents and Children Protection Act of 17 2023."

18 SECTION 2.

19 Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 20 general provisions regarding parent and child relationship generally, is amended by adding
- 21 a new Code section to read as follows:
- 22 "19-7-7.
- 23 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 24 (1) 'Biological sex' means the male or female sex phenotype as observed at birth based
- on physical differences and physiology, or, when necessary, by genotype, at the
- 26 <u>chromosomal level.</u>
- 27 (2) 'Child' means an individual under the age of 16 years.
- 28 (3) 'Gender identity' means actual or perceived sex and a person's gender expression,
- 29 <u>including actual or perceived gender-related self-image, appearance, behavior,</u>
- 30 expression, or other gender-related characteristics, regardless of the biological sex of the
- 31 <u>individual.</u>
- 32 (4) 'In loco parentis' means exercising control over a child as a caregiver or pursuant to
- 33 the performance of services as a member of the staff of any private school or public
- 34 <u>school, including charter schools; social services agency; public library; camp; or similar</u>
- facility or program.
- 36 (5) 'Information of a sensitive nature' means:
- 37 (A) Sex education, including programs providing sex education pursuant to Code
- 38 Section 20-2-143; and
- 39 (B) Information regarding a child's sexual orientation or gender identity, other than the
- 40 child's biological sex.
- 41 (b) No adult acting in loco parentis shall provide to or obtain from a child information of
- 42 a sensitive nature without the express written permission of the child's parent or legal
- 43 guardian.

44 (c) If a child indicates a desire to discuss information of a sensitive nature with an adult

- 45 <u>acting in loco parentis, such adult shall not engage in such discussion without the presence</u>
- or the express written permission of the child's parent or legal guardian.
- 47 (d) No adult acting in loco parentis shall engage in instruction, education, or training of
- 48 <u>a child while dressed in a sexually provocative manner, applying current community</u>
- 49 <u>standards, as determined by the school, social services agency, library, camp, or similar</u>
- facility or program, without the express written permission of the child's parent or legal
- 51 guardian."
- 52 SECTION 3.
- 53 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 54 relating to student health, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 55 "<u>20-2-779.3.</u>
- 56 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 57 (1) 'In loco parentis' means exercising control over a child as a caregiver or pursuant to
- the performance of services as a member of the staff of any private school or public
- school, including charter schools.
- 60 (2) 'Student' means an individual under the age of 16 years.
- 61 (b) A student's official school record shall include and shall be maintained under the
- 62 student's legal name as provided at the time of the student's initial enrollment in the local
- 63 <u>school system.</u>
- 64 (c) Any request to change a student's official school record to reflect a change in the
- student's gender shall be in writing and accompanied by a copy of the student's amended
- birth certificate reflecting the change in gender and a written consent form signed by all of
- 67 the child's parents or legal guardians.

68 (d) No adult acting in loco parentis shall modify a child's official private, public, or charter

- 69 school record to reflect a change in the child's name, sex, or gender without the written
- 70 consent of all of the child's parents or legal guardians.
- 71 (e) This Code section shall apply to all private schools and public schools, including
- 72 <u>charter schools, within this state.</u>
- 73 (f) Any violation of this Code section shall be subject to, as applicable:
- 74 (1) Withholding of funds pursuant to Code Section 20-2-243, if violation by a public
- 75 school, including a charter school;
- 76 (2) Ineligibility to be a qualified school or program for purposes of Chapter 2A of this
- 77 <u>title, if violation by a private school;</u>
- 78 (3) Sanction pursuant to Code Section 20-2-200, if violation by certificated personnel;
- 79 <u>and</u>
- 80 (4) Forfeit of tax exemption status, if violation by a nonprofit organization."
- SECTION 4.
- 82 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
