A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 2 of Title 25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to regulation of fire and other hazards to persons and property generally, so as to require every public and private school and every early care and education program to have carbon monoxide detectors and warning equipment; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Chapter 2 of Title 25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to regulation of fire
9	and other hazards to persons and property generally, is amended by adding a new Code
10	section to read as follows:
11	″ <u>25-2-41.</u>
12	(a) No later than July 1, 2014, every public and private elementary and secondary school
13	and every early care and education program, as defined in Code Section 20-1A-2, in this
14	state shall have carbon monoxide detectors and warning equipment installed in such school
15	or facility in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the Safety Fire
16	Commissioner pursuant to subsection (b) of this Code section.
17	(b) The Safety Fire Commissioner, in consultation with the Department of Education and
18	the Department of Early Care and Learning, shall establish rules and regulations regarding
19	the installation, operation, inspection, and maintenance of the carbon monoxide detectors
20	and warning equipment required by this Code section."
