- 12 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
13 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
14 her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
17 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Deb will long be remembered for her
19 love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
20 fortune of knowing her.

22 join in honoring the life and memory of Deb Stevers and express their deepest and most
23 sincere regret at her passing.
